Smartdeck in the ACT undertook the restoration of three full sets of the prestigious New Zealand furniture brand Devon of which the replacement value would have been \$15 thousand dollars. Max Kunze, the hotel maintenance manager said that the furniture still had lots of life left but that it was an eyesore that devalued the outdoor recreation area of the hotel. Max said that the furniture had many years of accumulated coats of Sikkens and their in house maintenance crews lacked the time or expertise to bring the wood back to a satisfactory state. All furniture had to be taken off site for restoration and carried out in stages so as not to disrupt Hotel customers use of this area. Some sections of the furniture (Merbau Class 1 Durability) had to be replaced due to rot/decay. Max said the Waldorf is thrilled to now have a maintenance system that
